- 6. The Associational Director of Missions should coordinate the work of the association in organizing the work of our churches as they serve together.
- 7. The Associational Director of Missions should lead the association churches to serve together in ministry and missions.
- 8. The Associational Director of Missions should lead in organizing association meetings and trainings.
- 9. The Associational Director of Missions should seek new avenues of ministry and missions for the association.
- 10. The Associational Director of Missions should promote the work of the association in our churches through his presence in the churches as well as speaking about the association and distribution of associational materials.
- 11. The Associational Director of Missions should be an encouragement to the pastors of association churches by prayers, calls, messages and by spending time with them.
- 12. The Associational Director of Missions should seek to build relationships with the pastors and leaders of churches in the association.
- 13. The Associational Director of Missions should be technologically inclined to lead the association in modern times.
- 14. The Associational Director of Missions will be evaluated every two years by the Association Council.
