

EVERYTHING YOU'VE ALWAYS WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT SUMMIT CAMP BUT WERE AFRAID TO ASK!

1. THE CAMP STORE WILL BE OPENED AT SPECIFIED TIMES EACH DAY. Campers will be able to purchase snack items and t-shirts. Summit Camp will have a "store bank account" in which to deposit their snack money and any remaining money will be returned to the camper at the close of camp. You may send a store deposit with this registration. If you need to contact your child, please call the Parchment Valley Conference Center, 304.372.3675. 2. CAMPERS DO NOT HAVE INTERNET OR PHONE ACCESS UNLESS AN EMERGENCY OCCURS. In order to protect your child, the WVCSB Summit Camp is a closed campus. All visitors must report to the camp office upon arrival. PARENTS PLEASE NOTE: There is pool time available for the campers during the week. Lifeguards will be on duty. Thank you!

3. IMPORTANT INFORMATION: Registration begins at 3:00 p.m. on the first day of camp, and camp ends at noon on the last day of camp. Cabin assignments will be finalized during registration. Accessible facilities are available at Parchment Valley. Please make special arrangements in advance to assure proper planning for special needs. Phone 304.372.3675 prior to June 1.

4. REGISTRATION HELPS: Grades are based on the Fall 2022-23 school year. It is the responsibility of the WVCSB leadership, counselors, and parents sending children to ensure the safety of campers. If your child has a contagious condition - including pink eye, lice, MRSA, etc. - please call the WVCSB office and a full refund will be granted, 304.757.0944.

5. ATTENTION YOUTH LEADERS, PARENTS OR GUARDIANS: A \$50 deposit must be made by the sponsoring church for each camper and any chaperones who are planning on lodging at Summit Camp. The remainder of the fee must be paid prior or upon registration of camp. In order to receive the early bird price, the deposit must be paid by May 1, 2023. Pre-registration fees are applied to the total cost with the balance due upon arrival at the camp. Full refunds can be given, if requested, by Thursday, June 1, 2023. Cancellations after that time will result in loss of the \$50 deposit. Refunds will NOT be given after the start of the camp.
