



EVERYTHING YOU'VE ALWAYS WANTED TO KNOW ABOUT SUMMIT CAMP BUT WERE AFRAID TO ASK!

1. DIGITAL COMMUNICATION AND VISITOR POLICY: WVCSB Summit Camp maintains a closed campus to ensure camper safety, with limited internet and phone use. Campers may use cell phones before and after daily programming at designated times. All visitors must report to the camp office upon arrival. In case of an emergency, parents can contact the camp directly at 304.465.2800.

2. REGISTRATION AND DORM ASSIGNMENTS: Registration begins at 3:00 p.m. on the first day of camp, and camp concludes at noon on the final day. Dorm assignments will be finalized during registration.

3. SPECIAL NEEDS AND ACCESSIBILITY: Summit Bechtel offers accessible facilities. To ensure we can accommodate special needs effectively, please make special arrangements in advance. Contact Tim Turner via email at tim@wvcsb.org or by phone at 304.759.8577, no later than June 1.

4. REGISTRATION GUIDELINES AND HEALTH POLICY: Grades are based on the 2023 and 2024 school year. It is the responsibility of the WVCSB leadership, counselors, and parents sending children to ensure the safety of campers. If your child has a contagious condition - including pink eye, lice, MRSA, COVID, etc. - please call the WVCSB office and a full refund will be granted, 304.757.0944.

5. PAYMENT AND CANCELLATIONS: A \$50 deposit must be made by the sponsoring church for each camper and any chaperones who are planning on lodging at Summit Camp. The remainder of the fee must be paid prior to or upon registration at the camp. In order to receive the early bird price, the deposit must be paid by May 1, 2024. Pre-registration fees are applied to the total cost, with the balance due upon arrival at the camp. Full refunds can be given if requested by Thursday, June 1, 2024. Cancellations after that time will result in the loss of the \$50 deposit. Refunds will NOT be given after the start of the camp.

- ☐ Pets

- ☐ Drugs (All prescription drugs must be in original bottles and given to the camp nurse at registration. No drugs are to be kept in the cabins.)
- ☐ All tobacco products including vaping, Zyn pouches, etc.
- ☐ Weapons (knives, guns, nunchucks, etc.)
- ☐ Valuable jewelry items
- ☐ Electronic games
- ☐ Cell phone use is ONLY permitted before and after daily programming, and during approved times. In the event of an emergency, please call the camp directly at 304.465.2800.
