

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

- 1. DIGITAL COMMUNICATION AND VISITOR POLICY: WVCSB Summit Camp maintains a closed campus to ensure camper safety, with limited internet and phone use. Campers may use cell phones before and after daily programming, and during approved times. All visitors must report to the camp office upon arrival. In case of an emergency, parents can contact Davis & Elkins College directly at 304.637.1900.
- **2. REGISTRATION AND DORM ASSIGNMENTS:** Registration begins at 3:00 p.m. on the first day of camp, and camp concludes at noon on Friday. Dorm assignments will be finalized at registration.
- **3. SPECIAL NEEDS AND ACCESSIBILITY:** Davis & Elkins College offers accessible facilities. To help us accommodate special needs, please make arrangements in advance. Contact Tim Turner at tim@wvcsb.org or 304.759.8577, no later than June 1.
- **4. REGISTRATION GUIDELINES AND HEALTH POLICY:** Please register your student based on the grade they will complete in Spring 2025. It is the responsibility of the WVCSB leadership, counselors, and parents sending children to ensure the safety of campers. If your child has a contagious condition such as pink eye, lice, MRSA, or COVID please call the WVCSB office at 304.757.0944, and a full refund will be granted.
- **5. PAYMENT AND CANCELLATIONS:** A \$50 deposit must be made by the sponsoring church for each camper and any chaperones who are planning to lodge at Summit Camp. The remainder of the fee must be paid prior to or upon registration at the camp. To receive the early bird price, the deposit must be paid by May 1, 2025. Pre-registration fees apply to the total cost, with the balance due at camp check-in. Full refunds can be given if requested by Thursday, June 1, 2025. Cancellations after that date will result in the loss of the \$50 deposit. Refunds will NOT be given after the start of the camp.

what not to bring*

Pets
Alcohol
Drugs – All prescription medications must be in original
containers and turned in to the camp nurse at registration
No medications may be kept in dorms.
All tobacco products, including vaping devices and
nicotine pouches (e.g., Zyn)
Weapons (knives, guns, nunchucks, etc.)
Valuable jewelry items
Electronic games or handheld gaming devices
Cell phones may ONLY be used before and after daily
programming or during approved times. In the event of
