Grill Walk

Nursing Home Visits

Volunteers will have the opportunity to encourage residents and staff at Mercer Nursing & Rehab, Westwood Center, and Bluestone Health & Rehab (The Maples). With approximately 240 residents, our goal is to visit each one personally and share the love of Christ. Working in pairs, volunteers will go room to room offering a small gift, prayer, and conversation. Staff will also be honored with gift baskets as a token of appreciation for their care and dedication. This is a meaningful outreach for individuals and families called to minister through presence, prayer, and compassion.

Block Party / Assisted Living Lunch

Prayer Walk (First Responders – Goodie Tray)

Bluefield is a historic city in Mercer County, West Virginia. As part of the Day of Service, volunteers will walk through the east end of the city, praying for residents, workers, and the community. The goal is to engage people through prayer, encouragement, and connection to the local church and, most importantly, to Christ. Volunteers will initiate conversations, offer prayer, and look for opportunities to share the gospel. When appropriate, they may also offer a Bible.
